**MAP Accelerator:** This is a computer-based program that targets students' individual mathematical needs. It is very important that your student work on this program daily. Students will be given some time in each intervention class to work on this program and are required to complete at minimum 20 minutes each day. Minutes not completed in class must be completed at home. A weekly grade from Sunday-Saturday will be submitted on Mondays. Students are encouraged to complete more than the minimum minutes in order to help them attain higher scores and achieve their goals on their next MAP Assessment. All Bonus points will be included in the Weekly MAP Grade.

**Classwork & Expectations:** Students will be expected to take notes, complete mathematical problems and contribute to class discussions daily. Grades for class work and class expectations will be given to students.

**Homework:** Homework must be completed by the assigned due date.

**Extra Help Nights:** Students will be able to stay with teachers on Thursdays from 3:05-3:45 for extra help or to make-up work.
